Twins Crew is a Swedish Power Metal Band founded in 2007 which presents its third album named "Veni Vidi Vici".

A bombastic intro sounding completely like Power Metal introduces the album and directly afterwards the opener and also title track beats one round the head with a melodic and stamping turn. It promises a lot by the melodic lead guitar at the beginning. The vocalist also convinces with low-pitched as well as high-pitched singing. However, the refrain is quite nice but the hope that the song remains in memory ends not later than now.

Even more convincing is the up-tempo-song "Show No Mercy" with a memorable chorus. Certainly, the album lost a bit quality by now. "Burn The Witch" envelopes to a really cool mid-tempo-song remaining directly in memory although one would initially suppose a boring ballad. It might also go down well on stage. Also "Out Of Time", "Forever Free" and "Under My Command" know how to please. Unfortunately, the last song "Ghost Of The Seven Seas", which was surely thought as song animating one to join in roaring, annoys me a little bit. Other bands have done it much better.

Conclusion:

"Veni Vidi Vici" created by Twins Crew isn't a bad album at all. Unfortunately, great melodies and refrains are missing and that is exactly what one is really expecting of Power Metal .
