Not just since the review of the current Narbeleth album, we know that South America has a thriving Black Metal scene. So, there is a Black Metal debut to the year 2016 namely the second album of the Brazilian trio Bode Preto.

It is nearly Grindcore-level that remarkable 14 songs have been compressed into a duration of 30 minutes. Three songs pass away when one briefly goes off on a tangent and due to this fact it is worth to listen to it carefully.

All of the songs win over with a dense atmosphere, classical Black Metal riffing and an incredible speed. However, now and then there is a bit time for melodic parts as e.g. in "Dirty Honey", "Mystic Massacre" or "Seizures of Fear". The sound far from high-polished runs through the entire album. In its rough and unadjusted form it is another stylistic device that shows how deep the band carries the ghost of the 80thies.

Conclusion:

If one takes the time to listen to the album a several times, more and more details will stand out that make the album better and better with each run. Sometimes it doesn't need an 60-minute-epos with 3-4 songs to say everything you want. However, at this point a longer duration would have been adequate, as the whole thing sounds slightly haunted and one can hardly get oneself into the songs.
